

WELCOME ABOARD, CAPTAIN!

Is this your first trip with us? Just follow these simple steps to get started.

START

Follow these 3 steps in this order:



Put in the draining plug

Put the draining plug in the hole in the floor before more than 1 person goes on board. Then press the handle of the plug down so it is parallel with the floor, and no water comes in.



2 Disconnect the power plug

The boat cannot be activated as long as the blue power plug is connected. The cable can be retracted just like a vacuum cleaner cable.



3 Activate the boat

Press the start button in your booking confirmation email and follow the instructions. When the boat is activated, the blue light on the back of the table switches on.

Or, use the link in the reminder SMS.

You're ready to go! Use the black lever to go forwards and backwards, and the big wooden rudder to steer left and right.

RETURN

Follow the same steps in **reverse** order:



Deactivate the boat

Press the stop button in your phone's browser to deactivate. The blue light on the back of the table switches off.



Connect the power plug

Connect the blue power plug to the socket on the jetty after you deactivated the boat.




3 Pull out the draining plug

This way any rain water can leave the boat in case it rains before the next trip starts. Leave it in if no rain is expected for the day.

Leave the boat clean and tidy for the next captain! Remove any garbage and use brush and cloth to clean up.

RULES & SAFETY

- Safety first, never take any risks.
- No more than 12 people are allowed on board. If you are more than 12, book an additional boat.
- Always drive starboard (on the right) and give way to boats coming from the right. Maintain a speed that does not bother other people on the water. The speed of the boats is limited to the maximum speed limit on the canals.
- Give way to paddlers and always be clear in the course you are driving. Approach corners and bridges in such a way that you are visible to fishermen and potential oncoming boats. Mind your head when driving under a bridge!

- It's prohibited to drive a boat when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Stay away from the restricted areas marked on the map. Sailing here can disturb freight traffic and cause danger.
- It is not allowed to moor to trees, under or to bridges and wherever this is indicated by a prohibition sign.
- There are people as well as birds living next to and on the water. Don't disturb them or cause any inconvenience such as loud noise.
